

ORDER OF REFERENCE

Extracts from the Minutes of the Proceedings of the Senate, Wednesday, March 8, 1906:

"The Honourable Senator Thorvaldson moved, seconded by the Honourable Senator HARTY, that the Standing Committee on External Relations be authorized to inquire into the question of Commonwealth relations with particular reference to the position of Canada within the Commonwealth; That the Committee have power to send for persons, papers and records, and to sit during sittings and adjournments of the Senate;

That the evidence received and taken on the subject at the previous session be referred to the Committee; and

That the Committee be instructed to report to the House from time to time.
