CEIC—DIAGNOSTIC SERVICES

Question No. 2,942—Mr. Clarke:

With reference to the professional and special services recorded by the Canada Employment and Immigration Commission at page 32.6, volume II of the 1979-80 Public Accounts of Canada, with particular reference to diagnostic services (a) what services does this entail (b) what is a list of each contract of a value more than \$2,000?

Hon. Lloyd Axworthy (Minister of Employment and Immigration): (a) This program provides for the purchase of diagnostic services for CMC/CEC clients who have considerable

difficulty participating in the labour market. These services are purchased from agencies or individuals in the public sector under professional service contracts. Diagnosticians provide written reports and consultations to employment counsellors for which fees are paid in accordance with contracts.

An elaboration of the service is as follows:

(i) Identify the client for whom these services are appropriate.

(ii) Determine if the commission has a standing contract (for the current year) with an appropriate diagnostician. (These contracts are usually negotiated by area or regional staff.)

(iii) Determine if the client is willing to undergo diagnosis relating to his/her inability to obtain employment.

(iv) If a diagnostician is available and the client is willing, complete the Diagnostic Services Requisition.

(v) Refer client to diagnostician.

(vi) The diagnostician assesses the client, prepares a report and discusses it with the client.

(vii) The diagnostician sends his/her report to the counsellor who referred the client to him/her.

(viii) Upon receipt of the diagnostician's report, the counsellor continues his/her employment counselling sessions with the client.

(ix) If the diagnostician indicates that there is no reasonable prospect of assisting the client through the CEIC, and the counsellor(s) handling the case concurs that the client's employment prospects cannot be improved through available employment services, the client is referred to another appropriate agency.
