Member for Mississauga South (Mr. Blenkarn) in relation to a statutory item, such items are not treated as budgetary matters; they are for information purposes only. In this regard I refer Hon. Members to citations 484 and 498 of Beauchesne's Fifth Edition. Therefore I must rule that notices Nos. 9 and 13 are not receivable. That disposes of two of the three separate votes which were to take place.

MOTION FOR CONCURRENCE IN VOTE 1, DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE

Hon. Herb Gray (President of the Treasury Board) moved:

That Vote 1, in the amount of \$44,561,000 under the Department of Agriculture—Administration, in Main Estimates for the fiscal year ending March 31, 1984 (less the amount voted in Interim Supply), be concurred in.
