

Dear Sir Arthur,-

I hear that the position of the
Gymnasium is under discussion. As I have been
absent through ill-health, I am not familiar
with all the points bearing on that difficult
question. I beg most earnestly to direct your
attention to one point, Professor Traquair has
pointed out to me that the Physics Building can
only be extended successfully in one direction,
namely towards University Street; and I am quite
sure that before ten years have passed the ques-
tion of a larger Physics Building will be a
burning one. It is then most important to re-
tain room for such an extension on the ground
between the present Physics Building and Univer-
sity Street.
