

THE SENATE OF CANADA

BILL F.

An Act for the relief of Harriet Bertha Wiser.

Preamble.

WHEREAS Harriet Bertha Wiser, residing at the town of Prescott, in the province of Ontario, wife of Isaac Philip Wiser, manufacturer, who is domiciled in Canada and residing at the said town of Prescott, has by her petition alleged that they were married on the ninth day of September, A.D. 1891, at the city of Ogdensburg, in the state of New York, one of the United States of America, she then being Harriet Bertha James, a spinster; and whereas by her petition she has prayed that, because of his adultery since then, their marriage be dissolved; and whereas the said marriage and adultery have been proved by evidence adduced and it is expedient that the prayer of her petition be granted: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:—

Marriage dissolved.

1. The said marriage is hereby dissolved.
