

BRITISH COLUMBIA.

VICTORIA AND YALE.—The H. B. Co's Steamer "ENTERPRISE" leaves Victoria every Tuesday and Friday for New Westminster, arriving same day. Distance 80 miles, fare \$5.

Steamers "ONWARD" and "LILLOET" leave New Westminster every Wednesday and Saturday for Yale, arriving on Thursdays and Sundays. Distance 100 miles, fare \$5. Returning, leave Yale on Mondays and Fridays.

VICTORIA AND NANAIMO.—Steamer "DOUGLASS" leaves Victoria on Tuesday at 7 o'clock a.m. for Nanaimo, touching at Cowichan, Maple Bay and Chemainus. Returning leaves Nanaimo for Victoria on Thursday. Distance 80 miles, fare to Chemainus and Nanaimo \$7.

YALE AND BARKERVILLE.—Barnard's Express and Mail Stages leave Yale every Monday and Friday on arrival of Steamer from Victoria. Leaves Barkerville every Wednesday and Sunday at 6 o'clock a.m.

FREE GRANTS OF LAND TO ACTUAL SETTLERS.

Land given away to all comers over eighteen years of age. A family of several persons can secure a Large Block of Land *gratis*.

The Government of Ontario offers, as a Free Grant to any actual settler, over eighteen years of age, One Hundred Acres of Land in the Free Grant Districts.

Heads of Families get Two Hundred Acres as a Free Grant.

Locatees, in addition to obtaining the Free Grant of One Hundred Acres, will be allowed to purchase an additional One Hundred Acres at fifty cents an acre, cash.
