## PORTS OF ENEARKATION.

London and Liverpool are the principal; but the latter place is infinitely preferable, both in respect to ships, and frequency of departure for every American port. Having engaged a passage on board one of those horses of the main, you proceed to obtain stores, according to circumstances; a frequent use of rhubarb, or Epsom salts, would be found beneficial during the passage. Finally, let me suppose the emigrant landed in safety, and in good health; if such intend to purchase land, to be careful ; in Upper Canada it is given conditionally to respectable men, but be cautions in the States: let no arrear of taxes be a kind of heir-loom, and be assured of a legal title, before you part with a dollar. I am sorry, as in duty bound, to recemmend and suggest a modern term in the flash vocabulary of the day, become deep files;---in one brief emphatic meaning, let greek meet greek. Itrevocably fixed in opinion, that such and other precautions I have stated, are indis-pensible-sI am inclined to admit, that a livelier pen than minie has formed for me an ultimatum.
