4.—“The Sheriff shall, immediately upon the receipt of his copies, cause one of them to be posted up in a conspicuous place in the Court House; the Clerk of the Peace, upon the receipt of his copies, shall cause one of them to be posted up in a conspicuous place in his office; every Public or Separate School Head Master or Mistress shall in like manner post up one of his or her copies on the door of the School House; and every Postmaster shall post up one of his copies in his Post Office.”—37 V., c. 4, s. 3; *Sub-sec. 2, “Act Respecting Voters’ Lists.”*
