

state for racing, (in which all concerned should be equally interested,) it is expected that every person training horses on the course, will conform to such rules as it may be found necessary to adopt for its preservation: all horses must take their walking and galloping exercise on the training track.

LXXVI.—All matters relative to Racing will be adjudged according to these rules, when any of them are applicable, and when not, according to the established laws of Racing.
