NICK YOUNG TALKS TO UMPIRES.

How Baseball Players in the Big League Are to be Held in Check.

Washington, April 10.—President Young of the National Baseball League has issued the following:

To League Umpires. Please note carefully instructions for 1909:

First—Wear a neat blue flannel uniform.

Second—Absolute honesty and sobriety are demanded of every umpire.

Third—Enforce the rules to the letter, just as they are written. Study to be master of yourself, and you can better control others.

Fourth—It is not necessary that you should hear every word that is spoken by players in the heat of a contest, unless it is violent, insulting or directed to or intended for your ear, or heard by others. In that case do not hesitate a second to do your duty.

No umpire can expect to hold his position unless he complies to the letter with his instructions, and no umpire need have any fear of losing his position who complies with the same, unless after a fair trial he is clearly incompetent.

Fourth—Consider all assignments strictly confidential.

Fifth—As soon as you reach any city let me know by first mail where you are stopping.

Sixth—Keep in close communication with your hotel, so as to receive a telegram at the earliest possible moment, and in case of accident, to be able to jump to some other city by first train.

Seventh—You and your associates should study the rules closely together, and anticipate plays and help each other as much as you possibly can, so as to reduce the chances for error to the minimum.

When Mr. — is umpiring at first base, and you have doubt as to the ball being fair or foul by reason of its closeness, he is in a position to judge to a certainty, and should give you a sign to guide you in making an absolutely correct decision.

By working together in this and many other ways the chances for making an error on the bases will be very small.

When the clubs are all in the east I will try and fix a day for a meeting of all the umpires, with a view to a correct understanding and interpretation of every rule and uniform application. N. E. Young.

THE HENDRIE 2-YEAR-OLD.

Trainer Whyte has nine 2-year-olds in training at the Valey Farm, as all of them are provincially-bred Quickstep.

Several of them are splendid new courses which is now being constructed near Mount Vernon for the Grand Circuit meeting.
