## MUSGRAVE IS SET DOWN CROWDING IN LAST RACE

### Glimmer Wins Dominion Handicap From Cannie Maid, Shimonee Third—Three Starters.

The Hamilton Jockey Club was favored with another large crowd and a fine day for their Wednesday races, when a card of seven events was run off with the Dominion Handicap the feature. Only three went to the post, two in this event from the Valley Farm, the other Dymont's Cannie Maid. This was the only small field of the afternoon. Cannie Maid went to the front, trying to make a run-away race, but after setting the pace she did away at the end to nothing. In the first race, the filly, Turf Star, was withdrawn, letting her stable companion, Bob E., carry the colors, which he did, but not to the front. The steeplechase was easy for Marksman. He was off well and won by three lengths, pulled to a gallop, John Dixon was always a contender, but could never reach the leader.

The day wound up well enough for the public when Woodwinder, the split first choice landed the long end of the purse. He went to the front at the releasing of the gate, and raced along to suit himself, which left him something to finish with when it came to the drive at the end. John Carroll could never get up, although he was hard ridden all the way by Preston. Musgrave pulled over in front of John Carroll and was set down for the meeting except in a steeplechase engagement.

The meeting of the Canadian Racing Associations yesterday brought out nothing of any importance. The only thing that was done was the granting of licenses for the Fort Erie meeting. "Bud" May sold Bob R. before the races yesterday to E. Hewitt for seven hundred dollars.

J. H. Madigan was at the Hamilton track yesterday and stated that the meeting at Fort Erie, which opens on Monday next, promises to be one of the best that have ever been held. There are already a number of horses stabled at the track, and with those to go from Hamilton, the number will exceed that of a year ago.
