

EXAGGERATED EGO TO KEEP THAW IN ASYLUM

Justice Mills Ruffles Assurance of Slayer of Stanford White.

WHITE PLAINS, N.Y., July 30.—It was the judge, not the prosecutor, who ruffled the assurance of Harry K. Thaw on the witness stand to-day. Exaggerated ego, "the insane delusion that the possessor is a person of supreme ability and importance," may prove the bar that will keep the doors of the Matteawan insane asylum closed upon him.

When District Attorney Jerome finished his cross-examination during the morning session to-day, Justice Isaac Mills, at whose term of the supreme court the slayer of Stanford White is standing to prove himself sane, put a series of questions that in the judgment of many were more pertinent than any asked during the twelve hours Thaw had been on the stand.

Taking up the lead suggested by the court, Mr. Jerome dwelt further on the "exaggerated ego," at the afternoon session, quoting from opinions of alienists at the homicide trials. He quoted Dr. Britton D. Evans, who had complained Thaw would not listen to arguments and could not be convinced.

Another report on the prisoner's "rapid flow of words and rapid manner" was a faculty of expression far beyond the normal.

This line of argument is taken to indicate that the state will strive to belittle the prisoner's general creditable showing on the stand on the theory that he was made glib, as it were, by the "exaggerated ego."

While Thaw faced well with Mr. Jerome, as he has done all along, he was worried to-day as he was before when the district attorney for the fifth time, asked him to define his mental condition now and when he killed White. He held dogmatically to the assertion that he had never been "medically insane," but that he might have been "legally insane" at the time of the shooting.

Mr. Jerome's examination lasted all morning, but on the whole Thaw matched his questioner promptly. Adjournment was taken to-day until Monday.

Every Thaw was in White Plains to-day, but did not appear in the court room. Nothing tangible has developed in the report that she will bring suit for divorce.

COMMITTED FOR PERJURY
Rockport Men Charged With Making False Affidavits.

BROCKVILLE, July 30.—(Special).—Newell Service, Fred Howarth, Rockport residents, charged with perjury in making affidavits to the effect that one Alexander Kirkwood illegally instructed in a polling booth in the Township of Escott Front on Jan. 4 last a voter named Cornelius McEwen to mark his ballot for local option, appeared for their preliminary hearing here to-day.

They were sent for trial, bail being accepted in \$200.

Rev. Thos. Leech took a hand in the game before the court adjourned by swearing out a warrant for the arrest of R. H. Service, father of Newell Service, on a charge of perjury. The charge, Service was in the court room, being one of the bondsmen for his son, and he was promptly taken into custody and arraigned before the justice.

Mr. Leech charged the jury with making a false affidavit in swearing that he (Leech) at the poll where all the trouble occurred caused voters, advocated the adoption of the by-law and showed voters how to mark their ballots. Service was committed to jail in \$150, and his preliminary hearing was fixed for next Friday.

"T" RAILS NOW.
The rails are being employed on College-street and Avenue-road, where the Street Railway are laying down new tracks. In the board of control meeting yesterday, Controller Hockley objected to the "T" rail on account of its destruction to wagon wheels after the brick or stone pavement had been worn into grooves on the inner side of the rails by horse drawn vehicles. Some time ago a stiff objection was made to the rails with "lips" on them, wherein ran the flanges of the car wheels, because of the inclination of narrow third rails to stick into the grooves. As it seems that the same difficulty is likely to be encountered ultimately with the employment of any styled rail, no action was taken by the city's executive.

Drowned in the Gatineau.
OTTAWA, July 30.—While going to his summer camp on the Gatineau River late last night Albert Bourgeois of Hull fell from his boat and was drowned in sight of his wife and family. He was charging cars and stood up, becoming dizzy and fell forward to his death.
