the Society, and has been its constant advocate and supporter. He has left it a memorial of his love for which our gratitude is due to his memory. His kindness, christian charity and integrity of life made him an example to all who will add obedience to Faith.

The Committee have also to regret the death of the Rev. J. F. Moody, one of the missionaries of this Society, whose zeal and piety promised much fruit in Christ's vineyard.

We trust that our departed brethren are with those who rest

from their labors, and whose works do follow them.
