## Flour Inspection Law.

At a Court of Common Council holden at the City Hall of the City of Saint John, on Friday the twelfth day of May, Anno Domini, 1848:

Read and enacted the following Law:

"A Law for the more efficient Inspection of Floura and Meal in the City of Saint John."

BE it Ordained by the Mayor, Aldermen and Common Council convened, That all Wheat Flour, Rye Flour, and Corn Meal brought or imported into this City in Barrels, Half-barrels, or Bags, (and not in the ensured the Provincial Treasurer for warehousing under the Provincial Treasurer for warehousing under the Provincial Yets in such case made and provided) shall immediately upon being brought into the City, disclarged or landed, and before being sold or offered for sale or eshipped or taken from any warehouse for consumption, or sent from the place where the same shall have been so discharged or landed, be inspected and weighed by one of the Inspectors and Weigher's appointed or horeafter to be apprecious and Weigher's appointed or horeafter to be appreciated.
