

RECORD LAZY MAN SLAYER, SUICIDE

Chided for Refusal to Work,
He Kills His Wife, Daughter
and Self—300 Pounder
Made Frail Woman Earn
His Living.

Little Ferry, N. J., Jan. 21.—The laziest man in the world shot and killed his wife, mortally wounded his sixteen-year-old daughter, Mary, and killed himself here when his wife chided him about his laziness. He was a 300 pounder, a former boxer who had fattened on the lips of his wife and children until he weighed 300 pounds. Mrs. Pepe was a frail woman, weighing about 115 pounds. She had done little or no work for two years. He was too lazy or too fat to climb upstairs, so he occupied a room on the ground floor of a little house in Liberty street. There he would loaf by the hour. When his children came home from work with their wages on Saturday night he would exact tribute—all the money they earned. The couple leave four children, Mike, eight; Angeline, sixteen; Rosa, twelve, and Anna, eight years old.

Mrs. Rose Pepe, the wife and mother, was devoted to her family and worked hard from morning until night in their behalf. She would send the children either to school or to work in the morning and then go to work herself, peddling vegetables she had bought from farmers. Invariably when she got home, the police learned, Pepe would demand the profits. This led to frequent quarrels between husband and wife and whenever the children raised their voices against their father he ruffed them violently.

Wife Causes Pepe's Arrest.
Neighbors who watched the middle-aged woman bring up the children during the fourteen or more years the Pepests have lived in this town of 2,000 population often sympathized with her. And she often sought their advice as to "what to do with my husband." Last July she caused Pepe's arrest for abandonment and non-support. He was locked up for

ten days, gaining his liberty through the efforts of his wife after he had begged her on his knees to free him, pleading that he would turn over a new leaf and go to work.

Once free he went home and showed activity for the first time in many weeks; he blackened both his wife's eyes as he beat and cursed her for humiliating him before the townspeople. There were other outbreaks, however, which the family remained silent through pride.

The police are convinced that Pepe planned to kill his entire family and then himself. If the four children who escaped injury had not fled from the house when they heard the police, the police think he would have killed them all, as he reloaded his pistol once and had four cartridges in his pockets. The weapon was a cheap .38-calibre revolver of the buldog type.

When they dashed from the house, and one of the bullets, which made the fourth wound received by his wife, was meant for his eighteen-year-old son, Mike.

Drags Frail Wife by Hair.

It all started with another quarrel at breakfast about seven o'clock in the morning. Angeline had started for her work at 6.45 o'clock after her mother had prepared her breakfast. Pepe, his wife and Mary were at the table. The other children, still in their rooms upstairs, heard a violent argument below, but since these had been of frequent occurrence lately they paid little heed to it. They knew their father often had threatened to kill their mother, but they did not believe he would.

Suddenly, according to Mike, Pepe grabbed his wife and shoved her half through a window. Then, apparently having forgotten what he really planned to do, he grasped her by the hair and dragged her back into the kitchen, a handful of hair remaining in his huge hand. Drawing his pistol he then shot her in the face, two bullets taking effect.

When Mike entered the room from the hall he found Mary struggling with her father. The boy carried his mother to the kitchen door and out onto a porch as the father freed himself from Mary with a push which sent her reeling to a corner of the kitchen. The mother was already dead. Following then she was dragged back into the kitchen, Pepe kicked both the boy and his murdered mother off the porch, stood above them several feet away, took aim and fired again. The bullet grazed Mike's coat and struck the mother in the head.

Mary shot as she pleaded.

Running back into the house, Pepe found that Mary had regained her feet. Although the young girl pleaded with her father to "stop and think what you've done," he pushed her into his room and shot her in the temple. Through a front window he fired shots at Rosa and Anna, but the bullets went wild and the children darted into the home of August Erdmann, next door.

Forced to reload his pistol, Pepe then walked into the room where Mary, unconscious, sat upright in a corner where she had fallen. Pepe then shot himself in the head as neighbors cautiously approached the house. He was dead when Erdmann and others entered.

The police took charge of the surviving children.
