



Heaven retaineth now our treasure, Earth the lonely casket keeps, And the sunbeams long to linger, Where our sainted mother sleeps.


Boston, April 10—No signs of an ex-tension to New England of the unau-thorized strike of railroad workers have yet appeared, according to officials of the three roads which enter this city.
