THE WAR SITUATION

In a powerful sermon in the first C. Kierstead, Pd.D., of Fredericton, told of the cause of the war and summing up eclared that war was wrong, the present conflict proving that the whole of Christian but that at times war appeared necessary when one nation seemed determined to appeal to brute force. 
