COLDS

A child should be encouraged to stretch its limbs and crawl about, as such activity promotes circulation and develops its musles. The little one should be rubbed all over, night and morning, with the palm of the hand. This is an excellent practice, especially at night, when it will often induce sleep in a child that is excitable and nervous.

The temperature of an infant's bath ought always to be determined by a bath thermometer. The bath should be given at 95 to 100 degrees for the first few-months; do not lower the temperature of the bath because the day happens to be warm. Put baby into the bath, using plenty of water. This is much more rapid and effective than any sponging process. Give baby a second dip in the evening before he is put to sleep. Never fail to do this in warm weather.
