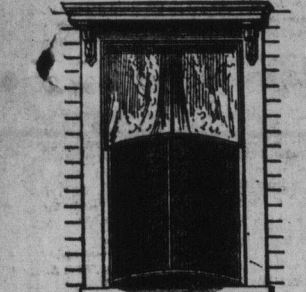

PATRIOTIC BISHOP SUSPENDS TRAITOR, ROSCOMMON PRIEST

Father O'Flannagan, Vice-
President of Seditious Sinn
Fein, Loses Parish—Parish-
oners Oppose Their Father
in God.

Dublin, July 25.—The Irish Independ-
ent this morning reports that Father
O'Flannagan, of Roscommon, vice-pres-
ident of the Sinn Fein Society, has
been suspended by his bishop for his
activities in the East Cavan election
last June, when Arthur Griffith, the
Sinn Fein leader, though under arrest,
was elected to the House of Commons.
Father O'Flannagan's successor to his
church at Cressna has been appointed,
but the newspapers say, the people
have refused to receive the new oc-
cupant and have barred up the church,
declaring that nobody will be allowed
to say mass there until Father O'Flan-
agan has been restored to his office.

FOUR PERSONS

LOSE LIVES
Husband, Wife and Children
Perish in Burning Hotel At
Peace River, Alta.

Peace River, Alta., July 25.—Henry
Ford, forty years of age; Mrs. Ford,
aged thirty, and their two daughters,
aged four and two years, respectively,
lost their lives this morning in a fire
which destroyed the Old Selkirk Hotel,
an old frame building. Fire spread
with remarkable rapidity, and other
inmates had very narrow escapes.

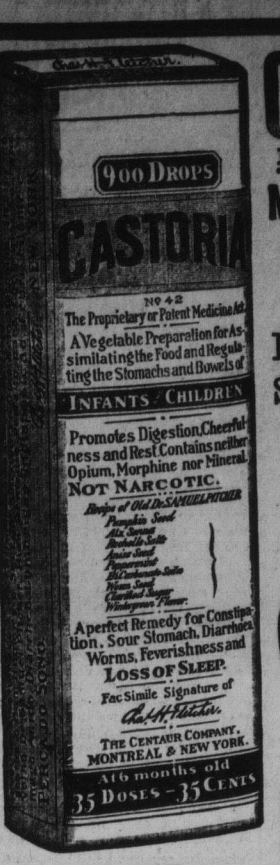
