

MULOCK, *Hon.* WILLIAM, M.A., Q.C., P.C. (*North York*).

Second s. of the late Thomas H. Mulock, M.D., T.C.D., a native of Dublin, Irel., by his wife Mary, dau. of the late John Cawthra, formerly of Yorkshire, Eng., who settled in Newmarket, and was elected as Reform member in the Leg. Assem. of U. C. for Simcoe, in 1829. B. at Bond Head, Tp. of West Gwillimbury, Co. of Simcoe, 19 Jan., 1843. Ed. at Newmarket Grammar School and Univ. of Toronto, where he was Gold Medalist in Modern Languages, and graduated in Arts in 1863. Called to the Bar of Ontario in 1868. Apptd. Q.C. by Ont. Government, 1890. For four years one of the Examiners in and Lecturer on Equity for the Law Soc. Elected a member of the Senate of the Univ. of Toronto in 1873 and 1878, elected Vice-Chancellor of the Univ. in 1881, and has held that position ever since. Is Presdt. of the Farmers' Loan and Savings Co., and of the Victoria Rolling Stock Co., and a dir. of the Toronto General Trusts Co. First returned to Parlt. at g. e., 1882, and re-elected at g. e., 1887, 1891 and 1896. Sworn of the Privy Council, and apptd. Postmaster General, 13 July, 1896. Re-elected by acclamation on acceptance of office. A Liberal.—68 Avenue Road, Yorkville; Toronto Club; Rideau Club.

OLIVER, FRANK (*Alberta*).

Of Irish and English descent. B. in the Tp. of Chinguacousy, Co. of Peel, Ont., Sept., 1853. Ed. at Common School. M., 1881, Harriet, dau. of Thomas Dunlop, Prairie Grove, Man. Is a journalist and proprietor of *The Edmonton Bulletin*. Sat for the dist. of Edmonton in the N. W. Council from 29 May, 1883 to 1884, and in the Leg. Assem. of the N.W.T. from g. e., 1888, to June, 1896, when he resigned, and was elected to the House of Commons. An Independent Liberal.—Edmonton, Alta.

OSLER, EDMUND BOYD (*West Toronto*).

Fourth s. of the late Rev. F. L. Osler, M.A. (Cantab.), Rector of Ancaster and Dundas, formerly of Falmouth, Eng., by his wife, Ellen Free Pickton. B. at Tecumseh, Co. of Simcoe, 1845. Is a share-broker; Presdt. of the Board of Trade, Toronto, and
