- (1) Respecting the disposition of the Railway Aid Fund, and that the proposal of the Government to grant aid to any railway should be submitted to the House, etc.
- (2) Amendment to amendment, respecting unrepresented constituencies, etc.
- (3) Amendment to amendment, respecting companies which have already acted under the provisions of the Railway Act, etc.
