**BILL to render the Notices of  
Sheriff's Sales more effectual and  
less expensive.**

**W**HEREAS it is necessary to render Sheriff's Sales more easy and less expensive in the several Districts of this Province, as well as to provide certain Regulations concerning the duties of Sheriffs and to define those duties more precisely: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of *Lower Canada*, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of *Great Britain*, intituled, *An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "An Act for making more effectual provision for the Government of the said Province of Quebec in North America," and to make further provision for the government of the said Province;* And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, that from and after the passing of this Act, the sale of any immovable property seized by the Sheriff, by virtue of any Writ of Execution, posterior to the passing of this Act, in what formsoever such Writ may issue, shall be advertised as follows: that is to say: for the Districts of Quebec, Three Rivers and Gaspé, in the French language only in the Newspaper now published in the City of Quebec under the name of "*Le Canadien*," and in the English language only in the "*Quebec Gazette*"—for the District of Montreal; in the French language only in the Newspaper now published in the City of Montreal under the name of "*La Minerve*"; and in the English language only in the Newspaper now published in the said City of Montreal under the name of \_\_\_\_\_; and lastly for the Inferior District of St. Francis, in the English language, (and also in the French language, until a Newspaper shall be published in the last named language within the said District,) in the Newspaper now published at
