

or Inferior Districts into which the said Province is now or shall or may be hereafter divided respectively, to provide himself or themselves with such like blank Books as are hereinbefore described, and others from time to time, when and as often as may be needful, and the said Prothonotary or Prothonotaries are hereby required and directed to enregister therein all such Judgments of the Courts of Law pronounced in any other of the Districts or Inferior Districts of this Province, when and so often as he or they may be required so to do, by any person or persons, upon paying to him or them the sum of _____ for enregistering each Judgment as aforesaid, and shall grant certificate of such enregistration when and so often as he or they may be required, and for such Certificate shall be entitled to have and receive _____ and no more.

X. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that where any Lands or immoveable Property held in free and common Soccage within this Province, shall be specially charged by any Contract of Marriage, the clause or clauses of such Contract so specially charging any such Lands or immoveable Property therein described, shall be enregistered in the Book of Registers aforesaid, and no Contract of Marriage creating a charge upon any such Lands or other immoveable Property in this Province, shall bind, or as a Mortgage or *Hypothèque* affect the same against a *bona fide* Purchaser thereof, unless the Lands or immoveable Property so intended to be charged, be therein specially mentioned, set forth and described respectively.

XI. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that every Registrar so to be appointed shall give due attendance at his office every day in the year (Sundays and Holidays excepted,) from the hour of ten in the forenoon to the hour of one in the afternoon, for the dispatch of all business belonging to the said Office; and every such Registrar, as often as he shall be required during the said office hours, shall make search concerning all Acts or Deeds, notarial or otherwise, enregistered as aforesaid, and give Certificates respecting the same, under his hand, if required by any person having an interest of any kind in any Lands or immoveable Property so enregistered, or intending to become a Purchaser of the whole or any part thereof, or to lend money thereon; and every such Registrar shall be entitled to demand and receive forthwith, for and after the entry and enregistration of any such Act, the sum of _____
