

An Act to amend the Laws respecting the Montreal Turnpike Roads.

HER MAJESTY, &c., enacts as follows :

Preamble.

- I. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the ordinance of the Governor and Special Council for the affairs of the then Province of Lower Canada, passed in the Session held in the third and fourth years of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled "An ordinance to provide for the improvement of the Roads in the neighborhood of and leading to the City of Montreal, and to raise a fund for that purpose," or in any ordinance or Act amending the same, the inhabitants residing within the limits of the Municipal Corporation of the Village of Lachine may travel on the Roads constructed or improved under the said ordinance, or any ordinance or Act amending it, with their carriages, horses and other animals, in every direction, within the limits of the said Village, and may pass through the Tollgates or Turnpikes erected on the said Roads, within the said limits, without being liable to pay any Toll for so doing, so long as they do not so travel beyond the limits of the said Village ; but, if they pass the same, they shall be liable to pay toll.

Inhabitants of Lachine may travel on the roads within the limits of the village without paying toll.
