C A P. XXXVII.

An Act for further continuing an Act, made in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for establishing Courts of Judicature in the Island of Newfoundland, and the Islands adjacent.* [7th March 1796.]



HEREAS the Law herein-after mentioned has by Experience been found useful and beneficial, and it is expedient that the same should be further continued; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That an Act, made in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for establishing Courts of Judicature in the Island of Newfoundland, and the Islands adjacent*, which was to continue in Force until the Tenth Day of June One thousand seven hundred and ninety-four, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament; and which, by Two Acts made in the Thirty-fourth and Thirty-fifth Years of His present Majesty's Reign, was further continued until the Tenth Day of June One thousand seven
