annual Income, arising from any Source whatsoever, of One hundred Pounds, or the Possession of Property, clear of all Incumbrances, exceeding Five hundred Pounds in Amount or Value.

II. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for Her Majesty, in Her Majesty manner aforesaid, to fix and determine the Length of the Period of empowered Residence within any Electoral District in the said Island which shall to lengthen Period of be required in addition to any other Qualification for voting at Elections Residence within such District, or for being elected to serve as a Member of the of Electors. Assembly; provided that such Period shall not extend beyond the Period of Two Years next preceding any such Election.

III. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for Her Majesty, in Her Majesty manner aforesaid, to restrain the said Assembly from appropriating to empowered the public Service within the said Island any Part of the public Appropria. Revenue thereof, in Cases where such Services shall not have been tion of previously recommended, or such Grants of Money shall not have been Revenue. previously asked, by or on the Behalf of Her Majesty.

IV. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for Her Majesty, in Her Majesty manner aforesaid, to restrain and prohibit the Election of Members to empowered serve in the said Assembly, in different Districts, on successive or to direct Elections to different Days, and to require that all such Elections shall be simul- be simultaneous, and shall be completed within a Time to be limited.

V. And be it enacted, That it shall be competent to Her Majesty, Her Majesty in manner aforesaid, to establish an Executive Council for advising may appoint the Governor of the said Island, apart and distinct from the Legislative Council. Council thereof.

VI. And be it enacted, That it shall be lawful for Her Majesty, in Her Majesty manner aforesaid, to abolish the Legislative Council of the said Island empowered as a distinct House or Branch of the Legislature thereof, and to to abolish authorize and empower the Members of the said Legislative Council as a distinct to sit and vote in the House of Assembly as Members thereof, as fully Branch of the in all respects as the elected Members of the said House: Provided Legislature; always, that the Number of Members so to be authorized to sit and vote in the said House of Assembly shall never be more than Two Fifths of the whole Number of the Members of such House of Assembly: Provided also, that it shall be competent to Her Majesty and to reagain, in manner aforesaid, to re-establish the Legislative Council as a establish it. separate House of the Legislature of the said Island.

VII. And be it enacted, That any such future Commission or In-Future Com-structions as aforesaid shall be laid before both Houses of Parliament missions to within Thirty Days next after the Date thereof, should Parliament belaid before Parliament. then be in Session, or if not, then within Thirty Days next after the Commencement of the then next Session of Parliament.

VIII. Provided always, and be it enacted, That no Change which Change in shall be made in the Constitution of the said Island under this Act Constitution shall continue for a longer Time than the First Day of September not to con-tinue beyond One thousand eight hundred and forty-six, unless Parliament shall a limited otherwise Time, onless
