Cars from the past

Vintage car enthusiasts will be able to see 'The Cars of Yesteryear', an exhibition of antique and classic cars from The Craven Foundation at Square One beginning today and ending Saturday April 14.

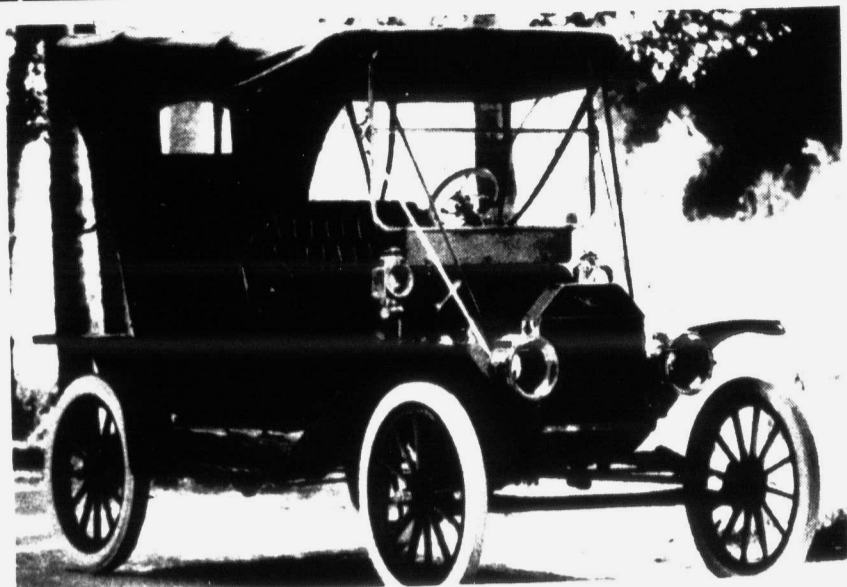
One of the highlights of the exhibition will be a 1909 Ford Model 'T', the car that almost single-handedly revolutionized the automotive world.

Since 1972, The Craven Foundation has featured cars of historical and cultural interest spanning the years

1901 to 1933.

The full collection, on display at the permanent home of the Craven Foundation at 760 Lawrence Ave. W. in Toronto, consists of 73 vintage and classic automobiles and 23 miniature automobiles from the Francis Morarini Collection, the only collection of its kind in the world.

The atmosphere of these by-gone years will be enhanced by live entertainment from Yesteryears from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. each day beginning tomorrow and ending Saturday April 14.
