On advice of Chief Link Officer, the Spencer Turbine motors in two instances were removed from the base of the Trainers and by using a round galvanized piece of piping, thereby losing the noise which in other instances had been found very trying to Instructors. Further, the flexible motor cables were run under the floor, which adds to the appearance of the room and facilitates cleaning. Lighting of the Link Trainer rooms is of an emergency nature at present, nor are the rooms properly ventilated. Improvements will be made as conditions permit. A series of tests was given to Entry #33, covering Mathematics, Armament, Signals and Sanitation & Health. Results most satisfying.
