and \$75.00 for those of the
Gallant. To Mr. Holliday of
the Prairie, supplies of flour
and land to the value of
about \$200.00 for the Indians
of Prairie, Seven Plains
and Katakuman; and to the
Anderson Bay Company's
Officer at Morgan, the same
of \$100.00 for the Indians
of that locality.

It is thought better to
entrust the whole of this
matter to you for the future,
as you were informed
would be the case when
your letter of instructions
relative to your duties
was sent to you.
