I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo, relative to the exchange of the St Boniface Industrial school property for three boarding schools to be erected by your Society; and in reply I have to inform you that the Department will require a report as to the sites upon which it is proposed to build these schools, as well as one from the Government Architect on the plans submitted, before it can authorize the buildings to be proceeded with.
