In reply to your letter of the 9th instant, regarding the desire of Indians of the Skwah Band, Chilliwack, B. C. to have the Department purchase for them a waggon valued at \$30.00 and a set of harness valued at \$40.00, I beg to say, that you should have forwarded to Head-quarters the requisition which you received together with a report setting forth the use to which the Indians intended to put the waggon and harness if supplied, and you should at the same time make a recommendation in the matter, setting forth your reason for recommending the purchase. The Department will expect to hear further from you in this connection.
