Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 20th instant, enclosing voucher No. 2992 in favor of Mr. Steekle, Assistant Provincial Live Stock Commissioner, Edmonton, for the amount of \$138.00, for advertising in connection with the stray horse round-up. In reply I beg to say that before this account can be paid it will have to be taxed by the King's Printer and before he can tax it the accounts for advertising, together with copies of the advertisements attached thereto, will be required.
