With Cheque.

Sir:-

Referring to your letter of the 21st instant, relative to land belonging to the Musqueam Band of Indians, which land is leased to Chinamen, I beg to transmit herewith cheque No 48 for \$643.00, rent money. This money should be paid to the Indians whose names appear on the rent return submitted with the letter quoted. You should be particular to pay to each Indian the amount due him, and to take a receipt in each case, which receipts should be forwarded to the Department, when the necessary entries will be made in the Department's books.
 (Note: The school authorities should pay the freight on these extinguishers.)
