Sir,-

I beg to draw your attention to the requisitions quoted below which call for the printing of letterheads for the use of this Department.

The crest printed on these letterheads is that used during the reign of Edward VII instead of that in use by the Department at the present time.

It is not understood how this mistake has occurred as sheets with the crest of George V. were forwarded with the requisitions as samples.

The above letterheads will be kept and used by the Department, but I have to request that you will be good enough to give instructions to have the crest of the reigning sovereign used in filling future requisitions.
