That D-147742, Pte. Jean BOURASSA, Régiment de la Chaudière, C.A., attached A-13 C.I.T.C., C.A., a soldier of the Canadian Army placed on Active Service, was by a General Court-Martial held at Valcartier Camp, P.Q., on the 8th day of May 1945, tried on the following charge:

That the accused pleaded Guilty to the charge and was sentenced to fourteen (14) months detention.

That the Judge Advocate-General has reported that the proceedings are regular, the Finding properly made and the Sentence according to law.

The undersigned has, therefore, the honour to recommend that the Finding and Sentence be Confirmed.
