With reference to your letter of August 8, there would appear to be no objection to the issuance of permits to Indians of the Band covering the removal of timber from the above mentioned reserve, subject to payment of dues at the rate of \$4.00 per thousand to Band Funds.

Presumably this rate is in excess of the combined Provincial Stumpage and Royalty paid by the Tidewater Contracting Company on their sale adjoining the reserve.
