the Society shall give written notice to the Secretary of her intention to resign and shall make payments of any dues in arrears.

Sec. 2. Members whose dues are in arrears for over 24 months and who do not pay same when called upon to do so by the Secretary, or give some satisfactory and reasonable excuse for non-payment, shall have their names struck off the list of members until such arrears are paid.

Sec. 3. Members who have repeatedly obstructed the business of the Society or defied the Chair in open meeting, shall be temporarily suspended from the privileges of the Society; and by a two-thirds' vote of the members present at a special meeting called for the purpose, may have their names finally erased from the list of members.

ARTICLE VI.

Officers of the Society.

Sec. 1. The executive officers of the Society shall be the President, Past President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and Chaplain.

Sec. 2. In addition to the above officers there shall be elected annually two Conductors, an Inner and Outer Guard, two Trustees, Pianist, and two Auditors.
