Harbor Master.

Scale of Fees payable to Harbor Master.

Fees payable by all vessels at the first and second port, where there is a Harbor Master, at which the vessels arrive during each calendar year.	
For every Ship of 50 Tons Register, or under.....	50 cts.
" " over 50 Tons, and not over 100 Tons Register.....	\$ 1 00
" " 100 " " 200 ".....	1 50
" " 200 " " 300 ".....	2 00
" " 300 " " 400 ".....	2 50
" " 400 " " 500 ".....	3 00
" " 500 " " 700 ".....	4 00
" " 700 Tons Register.....	5 00

Shipping Master.

HOWARD BLIGH.....OFFICE, 45 BEDFORD ROW.

FEES.—50 cents for shipping Seamen, and 30 cents for discharging the same, payable to Shipping Master.

Hospital Dues.

FEES.—2 cents per Registered Ton, payable at the Custom House. Vessels over 100 tons pay three times a year—under 100 tons once each Calendar Year on entering from a Foreign Voyage only.

Signal Dues.

ONE DOLLAR—payable at the Custom House. On entering from a Foreign Voyage vessels registered in Halifax and owned in other parts of the Province—*Free*.

Storage Rates, &c.

STORAGE RATES are the same as Wharfrage Rates, an extra rate being charged for labor—receiving and delivering; and if trucked into Warehouse from the Wharf at the expense of the Proprietor of the Warehouse an additional rate is charged, making in all three Wharfrage rates, for example—

The Storage on 1 case for 1 month would be...10c.
Labor, receiving and delivering.....10c.
Truckage from Wharf to Warehouse.....10c.—30c. or 3 rates.

LIGHTERAGE.—20 to 40 cents per ton. NOTE.—Ships generally discharge and load off the wharves.

BALLAST.—Stone, 40 cents; Clay, 30 cents per ton.

WATER.—Delivered on board, 50 cents per 100 gallons.

TOWAGE RATES.—Vessels under 150 tons, \$4.00; 150 to 200, \$5.00; 200 to 300 tons, \$7.00; 300 to 400 tons, \$8; 400 to 500 tons, \$10; 500 to 600 tons, \$12; 600 to 800 tons, \$15; 800 to 1000 tons, \$20. And \$2 for every 100 tons or parts of 100 tons additional. To Depot, North West Arm, Bedford, etc., and in and out of Harbor, as agreed upon, and in proportion to above rates. Rate of Service per hour—\$8 in Harbour; \$10 Outside. All unnecessary detention of the Boats charged at the rate of \$8 per hour. The above rates do not apply in case of assistance to vessels in distress, nor can they be considered fixed, but are subject to change by competition.
