Mr. Peters, Mr. Johnston, Mr. Gilbert, Mr. Price, Mr. Yeamans, Mr. Easterbrooks. It therefore passed in the affirmative. Mr. Coffin, Mr. W. Pagan, Mr. Leonard.

The House in Committee; Mr. Peters in the Chair, went into consideration of the Bill to enable the Justices of the City and County of Saint John, to assess the same for the purpose of defraying certain contingent expences of the Court of Sessions. The Speaker resumed the Chair, the Chairman reported that the Committee had made progress in the business to them referred and asked leave to sit again. The House agreed to the report.

Mr. Coffin by leave brought in a Bill to make more effectual provision for the repairing the Aboideau or Bridge across the Marsh Creek in the City and County of Saint John.

Read the second time, the Bill in amendment of an Act for regulating Fisheries. Ordered, that the said Bill be committed.

The House then Adjourned until to-morrow 11 o'Clock.

The Speaker informed the House that he had received a Letter from Mr. Wilson, Member for Westmorland, giving reasons for his not being able to attend the present Session.

Read the second time, a Bill to regulate the Packing of Salted Beef and Pork for exportation. Ordered, that the said Bill be committed.

The House in Committee, Mr. Leonard in the Chair, went into consideration of the Bill in amendment of an Act for regulating Fisheries. The Chairman reported that the Committee had gone into consideration of the Bill to them referred and had made progress therein, and requested leave to sitagain. The House agreed to the report.
