MANIFESTO

The following is taken from a mani festo issued on Wednesday last by the Ontario Branch of the Dominion Alli-

The most important issue before the electors of the Province of Ontario at the present time is the great temper ance question. The widespread and terrible evils that inevitably result from the bar-room and the treating sys tem demand the earnest and serious consideration of all patriotic citizens.

The problem with which the temper ance reform deals lies at the root of our national life and permeates the whole social organism. IT MUST BE DEALT WITH POLITICALLY.

The present Legislature has not only failed to promote such legislation, but HAS TAKEN FROM THE PEOPLE THE RIGHT, SO LONG ENJOYED AND NEVER MIS-USED, TO ABOLISH BAR-ROOMS LOCAL LY BY A MAJORITY VOTE OF THE ELEC TORS. The result has been the entrenching more securely than ever, so far as legislation is concerned, of the bar room system, with all its concomitant eyils.

We recognize the value of som amendments that have been passed, particularly in regard to the making ore effective the enforcement of the Liquor License Act, and there has been a tightening up of law enforcement generally, yet overshadowing all is the standing injustice of the requirement which gives the liquor traffic a voting strength practically 50 per cent. more than that of those who desire to see the bar-room abolished.

Believing this issue to be of para mount importance, and believeing that the only method by which we can se cure the results we desire is the election to the Legislature of representa tives who stand for the principles we advocate, we would call upon the elec tors of the Province to work and vote only for the nomination and election of such candidates as can be depended upon to do all in their power to secure at the earliest opportunity the enactment of effective legislation against the bar-room evil, and who will Hold THEMSELVES ABSOLUTELY FREE FROM PARTY DICTATION IN RELATION TO SUCH LEGISLATION.
