C. will at the end of the year be able to show some \$1600,000 surplus over regular dividends. The next dividend meeting should be held about the 15th of this month. Earnings of D. & H. have been showing notable gains, and for the year ending this month the company should show fully 16 per cent. earned on the stock. Distil-lers earned iast year only 7.88 per cent, against the 6 per cent, dividend rate; and working capital of \$10,300,000 is sev-eral millions smaller than in 1903, while volume of business was much smaller.
