ADVOCATES ABAN-ING BATTLESHIPS

Paris, June 9-In presenting France's programme of naval construction for the next three years. Deputy Paul Denise, reporter for the Navy Commission, advocated in the Chamber of Deputies today virtual abandonment of the building of battleships and battle cruisers and intensification of construction of submarines, torpedo boats, destroyers and airplane carrying ships.

programme provides for the construction of six light cruisers, twelve destroyers, twelve torpedo boats and thirty-six submar ines, at an approximate cost of 1,476,000,000 francs.


