SEVERE GLOBE FALSIFICATION

Yesterday we had occasion to point out wherein the Globe, for the purpose of assailing the national policy, has mistaken the figures with regard to our exports, and yesterday again falsified the figures in the trade and navigation returns.

Replying to a statement by a correspondent to the effect that he did not believe that the N. P. was anti-British, our contemporary refers him to certain figures which it says were taken from the trade and navigation returns.

It may not be out of place just here to enquire—in what way the coal duties, even supposing them to be greater on British coal than on American, can injure the British coal producer provided that the Canadian consumer pays all the duty?

Our contemporary puts imports of cotton, bleached from Great Britain in 1920 at \$229,221. The trade and navigation returns put it at \$236,041. It puts the duty on this item \$69,059, the trade and navigation returns give \$49,439.

Some also of goods from the United States \$286,910, duty \$73,450. The trade and navigation returns give these imports \$643,256, duty \$115,565.

According to the Globe we imported of gingham from Great Britain \$18,921, duty \$29,999 and from the United States \$10,178, duty \$3,864.

According to the trade and navigation returns these figures stand: From Great Britain \$13,065, duty \$29,943, and from the United States \$8,603, duty \$7,178.

In other words on two articles of imports the Globe wilfully falsifies to the tune of \$276,638 in value, and \$10,166 in duties.
