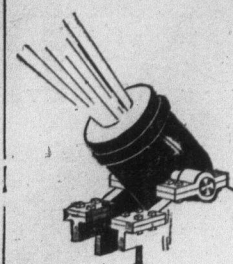

**COURT OF REVISION.**  
The Court of Revision for Local Improvement Assessments, was held on Monday afternoon with Aldermen Bricker, Weber, Gross and Collard present.

The assessments on Courland ave. and Frederick-st. roadways were maintained. That on the David-st. roadway was accepted, less 21 feet in front of bridge at park charged to Mr. Collard, changed to the town.

The proceedings were read at Council.

**DEFECTIVE SEWAGE.**  
During Monday a lot of filthy refuse came into the cellars of Messrs. Smith Bros. Five or six barrels of refuse, and caused not only a bad stench, but considerable damage. Mr. Collard, chairman of the Council, about it. The Council is investigating. Both the Mayor and Chairman Honsberger expressed regret that the sewage gentlemen should have been inconvenienced.

A motion to buy new gates and improve the cemetery, involving an expenditure of about \$300, was opposed by the Mayor. He considered that the expenditure should be foregone this year, as the Council has had large unforeseen expenditures, \$1200 of such money has already been expended.

Mr. Bricker thought the work should be done as it had been placed in the estimates.

Ald. Weber contended that some improvement is necessary; that the gates there are no use and that the cemetery is neglected.

Ald. Braun considers it high time that some steps are being taken to improve the cemetery. Other towns pay considerable attention to their burial ground and so should Berlin.

Ald. Collard said he would support the motion.

Mr. Vogt said the cemetery is being allowed to run down and should be improved.

Action has been deferred until the 15th inst.

The chairman of the Board of Works was authorized to buy the necessary stone for macadam road building.

A by-law was passed for the issuance of a debenture of \$5,200.00 for local improvements in 1901.

Mr. D. R. Detweiler was appointed to the late Hugo Kraus.

Mr. A. L. Brethaupt was also moved. He had two supporters.

The Sewerage committee recommended the accepting of R. Boehmer & Co's tenders for sewers on Ellen and Queen, \$615. On Joseph-st., \$1192, and allowance of \$250 for curbing lumber left in the Margaret ave. sewer.

The Berlin & Preston St. Ry. Co. asked Council to take the necessary steps to grant the company the franchises decided upon in the Spring.

The Board of Works put in a special report, dealing with matters already appearing in print.

Thos. E. Nichols, Hamilton, offered to put up new gates at the Cemetery for \$250.
