
The balance sheet

In 1988, Canada recorded a trade surplus in an increasingly competitive trading environment. The value of its merchandise exports reached \$138.1 billion and its imports, \$131.7 billion for a surplus of \$6.4 billion, compared with \$8.9 billion in 1987.
