

This is a university-to-university exchange for students as well as faculty. The exchange is open to members of all university departments. In 1994, three Augsburg students studied at UBC and three UBC students came to Augsburg.

At Augsburg, students are selected by the Institute for Canadian Studies; at UBC by a committee of representatives of the university.

The program includes a tuition waiver for students at the partner university. Students pay for travel and accommodation. Canadian students may apply for a "DAAD-Kontaktstipendium", if they are eligible – i.e. a grant which, apart from a tuition waiver, includes a monthly allowance of DM 400 to DM 940, including the costs of accommodation. Travel costs are paid by the students. Students remain enrolled at their home university, but are usually given special leave status.
