TWO EXTERNAL AFFAIRS APPOINTMENTS ANNOUNCED

The Honourable Paul Martin, Secretary of State for External Affairs, today announced two senior diplomatic appointments:

Mr. Max H. Wershof, Q.C., at present an Assistant Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs and Legal Advisor in Ottawa, to become the new Canadian Ambassador to Denmark, and Mr. Paul André Beaulieu, Q.C., currently serving as the Canadian Ambassador to Brazil, to become Deputy Permanent Representative and Ambassador to the United Nations in New York.
