DIPLOMATIC APPOINTMENT

The Right Honourable Joe Clark, Secretary of State for External Affairs, announces the following diplomatic appointment:

Mr. Anthony T. Eyton born in Quebec City, Quebec, as Consul General in New York.

Mr. Eyton (B. Comm. Economics, University of Toronto, 1964) joined the Trade Commissioner Service in 1964. He served abroad as Second Secretary (Commercial) in Lima from 1965 to 1968; as Counsellor (Development and Commercial) in New Delhi from 1971 to 1974; as Executive Director, Asian Development Bank in Manila from 1975 to 1977; and as Ambassador in Brasilia from 1983 to 1986. In Ottawa, he was Director General of the Trade Commissioner Service and International Marketing from 1980 to 1981; Assistant Deputy Minister, Personnel, External Affairs from 1982 to 1983. He has been Assistant Deputy Minister, Economic and Trade Policy since September, 1986. He is married to June Taylor. Mr. Eyton replaces Mr. Robert Johnstone.
