

*Customs Tariff*

That Bill C-87, be amended in Clause 19 by striking out lines 43 and 44 at page 5 and substituting the following therefor:

"other Act of Parliament.

(3) The rates of customs duty set out in Schedule I and section 46 and the customs duties imposed by this Act are further subject to such increases, reductions, removals or other exceptions as may be specified in any regulation or order made under this or any other Act of Parliament, provided that no such regulation or order shall have effect for more than sixty days unless it is adopted by resolution of both Houses of Parliament."
