

The formula they agreed on involves a combination of seeded acreage, production and grain values. The farm leaders left it up to the Minister and his officials to iron out details, and to determine a base year.

Now the consultation process is complete. Calculations are being done. And an announcement will be made as soon as possible.

Mr. Speaker, I do not think this Government has to be reminded of the urgency of farmers' cash flow problems. It is this Government that has responded in the past with a strong

record of initiatives on behalf of Canadian farmers—a record that stacks up very well against any other.

And we fully intend to deliver special assistance to grain and oilseed farmers—not just quickly, but also fairly and equitably.
